

Sponsorship level	Amount	Description
Main event sponsor	£4,000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Main Event Sponsor will be the most prominently displayed on all event materials including the website, student posters, all email correspondence and any event brochures. They will also be given the opportunity to give a 45 minute talk to the entire conference audience. They will be offered the choice of either closing or opening talk to suit their preference. The Main Event Sponsor will also be given 10 complimentary tickets to the evening dinner at South hall.
Secondary sponsor	£3,000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Secondary Sponsor will be displayed on the website, student posters and any event brochures, the second most prominent. 30 minute talk, either opening or closing depending on Main Sponsors choice. 5 tickets to the evening dinner.
Tertiary sponsor	£2,000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tertiary sponsors will be displayed on the website, student posters and event brochures. 15 minute talk in a parallel breakout session relevant to their field. 2 tickets to the evening dinner.
Dinner sponsor	£1,750	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Dinner Sponsor will be displayed on the website, student posters and event brochures. The sponsor will be given the opportunity to provide a 10 minute opening speech at the drinks reception. The Dinner Sponsor will receive 5 tickets to the dinner.
Poster sponsor	£1,500	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sponsor of the Poster Prize. The sponsor will be invited to assess the conference posters, as well as giving a small speech and awarding the poster prizes. The Poster Prize Sponsor will be displayed on the website, student posters and event brochures.
